Credit value and level of credits permitted through credit transfer and the award of credit through the recognition of prior learning (RPL)	<p>The RPL and credit transfer rules can be applied to both mandatory and optional units. No more than 30 credits required for the Level 3 Diploma award may be awarded through RPL or credit transfer.</p> <p>No credit is awarded where previous learning has already been certificated; students will be exempt from relevant credit requirements. RPL or credit exemption will normally be awarded only for subjects or units relevant to the named Diploma. The One Awards RPL and Credit Transfer policies and application processes must be adhered to in all cases.</p> <p>Centres must advise students to contact their intended receiving institution before starting their Level 3 International Diploma to HE Programme. Students must ensure that the Diploma will be accepted by the HE institution and that the subject choices, and any credit exemption made, are appropriate for progression to their proposed higher education programme.</p>
Other requirements	Full completion of the Diploma must occur within five years of initial registration.
